Overview & Purpose- The Gospel

Question of the day: Who is Jesus?

VERSE

Jesus says "no one has ever seen God, but the 1 and only son, who is himself God and is in closest relationship with the Father, has made him known ". **John 1:18**

Read the verse with the kids and ask them our question for the day. Please be sure to point out the clue in your room and ask the kids what other clues they have found so far.

Ask the kids to share some things that they know about Jesus and what they are learning so far.

We want this time to be less of a lesson and more of a conversation. We want a chance for the kids to think through these ideas and voice their thoughts. Explain that we are making fingerprint crosses today to remind of what Jesus really did for us. This isn't just a made up story. Jesus really loved us enough to die for us.

Materials Needed

Cardstock with cross printed on it,

paper plates at each table

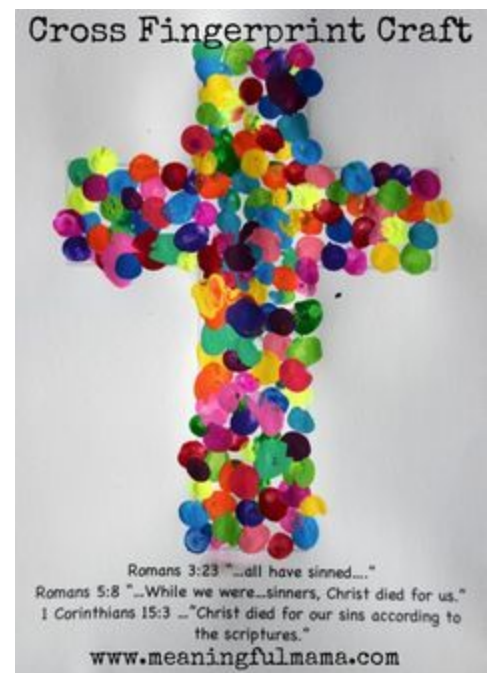
washable paints

Paper towels to clean hands

Directions:

A cross printed on pieces of heavy-duty cardstock with a key verse that you are learning. Have acrylic craft paint ready for the children in a variety of colors so they can fingerprint decorate their crosses. This will remind them that Christ died for them, and that he knows and created every detail of their being, down to their fingerprints.
