## Overview & Purpose- Equipping

***Question of the day: How do I do it?***

### **VERSE**

Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms. **1 Peter 4:10**

Read the verse with the kids and ask them our question for the day. Please be sure to point out the clue in your room and ask the kids what other clues they have found so far.

Ask the kids to share some things that they know about what it looks like for them to follow Jesus and do what he did. Ask what they are learning so far. We want this time to be less of a lesson and more of a conversation. We want a chance for the kids to think through these ideas and voice their thoughts. Encourage them to ask questions. Explain that we are making this craft to remind them that Holy Spirit is with them just like Holy Spirit was with the first disciples (followers of Jesus).

## Materials Needed:

Toilet paper roll, yellow and orange tissue paper cut in 4x6 inch rectangles, glue sticks, scissors, battery tea light candle

## Directions

Have the kids get two sheets of yellow tissue paper and two sheets of orange tissue paper. They are going to cut each sheet individually to look like flames of fire. They are then going to glue each layer of tissue paper around their toilet paper roll to look like fire. Once they are done with the glueing, please give them a tea light to make it look like it's really on fire.
