HERE'S WHY;

Parents play a vital role in their children's faith development. No matter how busy you are, make the spiritual discipleship of your children a top priority. Know that you don't have to be a spiritual "expert" to train your children, just open your Bible and read it with your kids. If they have questions, point them to God's Word and search out His truths together.

Be sure to make prayer a priority. Talk to God together and be open about what you need prayer for. When your kids see you pray and talk with God, it becomes more natural for them to do the same thing. Spend time two or three nights a week reading, talking and praying together. Remember, the Gospel message is simple to – even for a child. Pray that God would give you wisdom and that the Holy Spirit would bring clarity to your family as you learn together at home.

DAILY AT HOME SCHEDULE
